

Supply Chain Assessment Process & Policy

Arnts the Landscape Supplier will review its supply chains annually to identify, assess and monitor high-risk engagements with third parties. This assessment is also to be done for any potential suppliers we are considering importing goods from. Once a list of suppliers is gathered, the steps are as follows:

- Ensure all suppliers have been sent our <u>Expectations of Suppliers</u> document to review;
- Plot Suppliers on the <u>global slavery index map</u> to determine if any of our supply chains are at risk;
- If a supplier operates in a mid-high risk area, survey the supplier regarding their policies and due diligence processes in relation to forced and child labour. We will conduct this survey via our **Modern Slavery Act Letter**;
- If the supplier's answer to our **Modern Slavery Act Letter** indicates a risk of forced or child labour we will develop a plan to manage that risk and assess our effectiveness in ensuring that forced and child labour aren't being used in our supply chains.
